Adverts are required in JPEG format. Full page adverts must be in "Portrait" (size $5" \times 7.5"$). Half page adverts must be in Landscape format (size $5" \times 3"$) and quarter page adverts can be either "Landscape" (size $5" \times 1.75"$) or "Portrait" (size $2.375" \times 3.75"$). In addition we can scale files to size and convert colour into grey scales if needs be.
